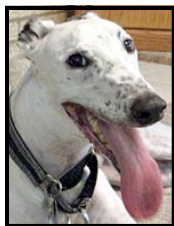

**Adopting a Greyhound**

GALT spends over \$500 to care for and prepare each healthy greyhound for adoption. Dogs with significant medical problems cost much more. All adoption groups do not offer the high quality medical procedures that GALT does. Be sure you understand before your adopt. The non-refundable, tax deductible adoption donation fee is \$350 for all Greyhounds under 7 years, \$275 for GALT Cheerleaders, ages 7, 8 and 9, and \$225 for GALT seniors, age 10 and over.

**The adoption donation includes:**

- Neuter or spay
- All vaccinations (DHLPP, Bordatella & Rabies)
- A CBC (complete blood count) with serum chemistry panel
- A tick-borne disease panel by Protatek Lab\* to detect Ehrlichia Canis, Babesia Canis, Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever and Lyme with treatment if needed for each
- Heartworm test with negative results
- Dental cleaning & extractions if needed
- Fecal test & treatment until negative results are achieved
- Home Again Microchipping, Membership & benefits
- A special greyhound martingale collar and leash
- An adoption package with special greyhound information and many coupons

A **\$75** deposit is required with submission of the application (**\$50** of which is refundable and **\$25** of which is non-refundable). The remaining **\$275**, \$200 or \$150 adoption donation is due when the Greyhound is delivered to the adopter. An adoption application can be obtained from our website, one of our Meet the Greyhounds, or by phone request.

*\*This test detects diseases prevalent in Texas transmitted from a tick bite. Proper treatment will eliminate these diseases.*

- ★ Are friendly, gentle dogs;
- ★ Thrive on human companionship;
- ★ Love to be the center of attention;
- ★ Make wonderful household pets;
- ★ Are kennel trained, so they take to housetraining quickly, with a little TLC and patience;
- ★ Come in all sizes, colors and ages;
- ★ Weigh between 50-85 lbs and have a life expectancy of 12 to 14 years or more;
- ★ Require little exercise, but a nice walk 3-4 times a week will make them happy;
- ★ Are tolerant of children, preferring to walk away when they've had enough;
- ★ Are very social;
- ★ Are not used to cats, so extra time and patience may be required;
- ★ Require routine visits to the vet and good dental hygiene;
