General Event Information

This is an *on-leash* event with several separate off-leash areas (see map). Feel free to bring your pups. Also, please let me know if you will be doing on-site adoptions.

The Ticket is providing tents and tables for designated organizations as outlined on the "Barktoberfest Layout" map. Please find your tent assignments on the Layout map. We will have them set up for you that morning for you. If you need chairs, etc. you will need to provide them.

Please make sure you are set up by 9:30 am (schedule below). If you need to bring a truck inside the fenced area to unload/set up in the morning, you will need to be unloaded and move your vehicle outside the fence by 8:00 am.

Please see the Layout map for parking. When the Beach Street parking lot becomes full, traffic will be directed to the alternate entrance on Riverbank. (Parking is free.)

Fort Worth police officers will be on duty throughout the day.

All proceeds benefit Cowtown Loves Animal Shelter Pets (CLASP) in their effort to build the first animal adoption center in Fort Worth. This event is free, but CLASP will be accepting *optional* \$1 donations at the door.

The event officially ends at 2:00 pm, so please do not begin break down until that time.

Fort Woof Dog Park Location/Directions

Gateway Park

751 Beach Street, Fort Worth, TX, 76111

Fort Woof is located east of downtown within Gateway Park, north of Interstate 30 between Beach Street and Oakland Boulevard, east of downtown.

From I-30, exit Beach Street (just east of downtown Fort Worth), head north on Beach Street for approximately a quarter of a mile, and turn east (right) at the Gateway Park sign. Then proceed another quarter of a mile; Fort Woof Dog Park will be on your left.
